# 1 CONNECTION SETUP

Connect TrustBox to the Host PC using a USB-micro USB cable and follow the steps below depending on your host operating system.



## Windows

- ✓ Download and install the CP210x USB-UART driver from <https://bit.ly/2v0gwnS>
- ✓ Download and install PuTTY serial connection client from <https://www.putty.org>
- ✓ Open Device Manager and find the used COM port
- ✓ Start PuTTY and select Connection Type as Serial
- ✓ Go into Connection -> Serial. Enter the COM port, set speed to 115200, Flow control to None. Press Open button

## Linux

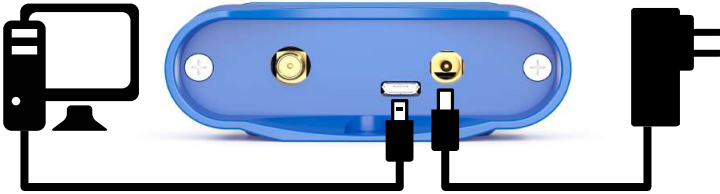
- ✓ Install picocom serial port terminal emulator
- ✓ Configure the connection using command:

```
# picocom -b 115200 /dev/ttyUSB0
```

## 2 FIRST LOGIN

Power on the board. You should see the loading process in the terminal window. Once the boot is complete login with the following credentials:

```
login: root
password: root
```

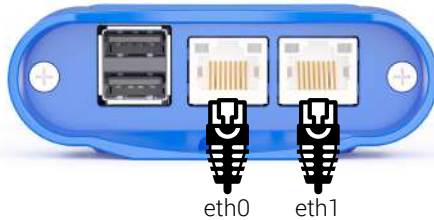


Note: do not forget to change the default password to a more secure one.

## 3 NETWORK

### Cable

- ✓ Connect device to the network using one of two Ethernet ports



- ✓ Configure the network via DHCP with the command:

```
# dhclient <eth0/eth1>
```

### Wireless

- ✓ Find the Wi-Fi interface name:

```
# iw dev | grep Interface
```

- ✓ Connect to the available WiFi Access Point:

```
# wpa_supplicant -B -i <interface_name> -c <(wpa_passphrase
<access_point> <password>) && dhclient
```
